

## **How does the CATCH THE ACE work?**

Tickets are sold at:

- Royal Canadian Legion North Bay, Branch 23 (150 First Ave. W.) office weekdays from 9:30 am to 5 pm;
- North Bay Mall (outside NO FRILLS) Saturdays 10 am to 2 pm; and
- Legion Branch #23 Dress Lounge Fridays from 4 – 7:30 pm.

The Draw of an envelope will take place at 7:45 pm in the Dress Lounge.

The Tickets are \$5.00 each.

A maximum of 1,000 Tickets will be sold each week.

On the Ticket, the Buyer will identify the Number of the Envelope that he/she believes the ACE OF SPADES is in. The Buyer whose Ticket that has been drawn will receive 20% percent of that day's sales.

30% of each day's sales will go towards the Progressive Accumulating JACKPOT.

The remaining 50% percent of the day's sales less expenses, such as the cost of printing the tickets, the cost of the playing cards, the Licence Fee, etc., will be given to several organizations.

We will then pull the Number of the Envelope that the Buyer believes the ACE OF SPADES is in.

If the ACE OF SPADES is in the Envelope, then the Buyer receives the twenty (20%) percent of that day's sales PLUS the Progressive Accumulating JACKPOT amount.

If the ACE OF SPADES is not in the Envelope, then we continue the CATCH THE ACE the following week. The Envelope and the Playing Card that has been drawn each night will be destroyed so as the DRAW progresses, the number of Envelopes and Playing Cards available to be picked go down.

The Buyer of the Ticket does not have to be present at the DRAW at 7:45 pm as he/she will have put their name, telephone number and the number of Envelope they want drawn on the Ticket.

The successful Buyer after the DRAW will be contacted to let him/her know how much money they have won and to arrange for the Buyer to receive their monies.

The results of each DRAW will be posted to the Catch The Ace Facebook Page.

The CATCH THE ACE will go for a maximum of forty (40) weeks or less depending upon when the ACE OF SPADES is found. If the ACE OF SPADES has not been found after the DRAW on Week Forty (40), there is a process in place to conclude the DRAW in Week Forty (40).

It is possible that the Progressive Accumulating JACKPOT by WEEK 40 could be as high as \$30,000.00.
