



Rotary Club of Washago and Area- Centennial

Scholarship Criteria

- The applicant must complete the application form with pertinent information.
- The applicant must live in the Washago/Severn bridge area. The area will be defined as the area serviced by the three public schools (Rama Central, Cumberland beach/ Ardtrea, K.P.Manson).
- There will, at this time, be one scholarship issued annually (\$500.00). The application deadline will be March 15 and the award will be presented between March 31 and April 30 of the given year.
- The Scholarship Committee of the Rotary Club of Washago may, at their discretion, alter the above mentioned dates, if unforeseen circumstances justify a change.
- The scholarship will be for post secondary education in a technical area. This will include Institutional training or an apprenticeship program. All training of an institutional nature will be at an institution recognized and registered by the Ministry of Education. Proof of acceptance and attendance will be required prior to the award being issued. Training by way of apprenticeship will require proof of registration with the Apprenticeship Branch of the Department of Labour and proof of employment in the chosen field. The definition of "Technical" will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee of the Rotary Club of Washago and Area – Centennial.
- The Washago Rotary Scholarship will not be awarded on more than one occasion to the same individual.
- All applications will be acknowledged. The name of the successful applicant will be notified and announced in a press release through the local media.
