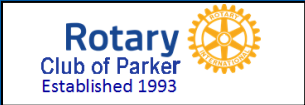

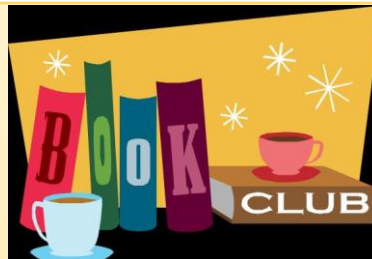


Thank you Michael Klene for donating a huge bag of yarn to the Parker Senior Center. It was well received.
