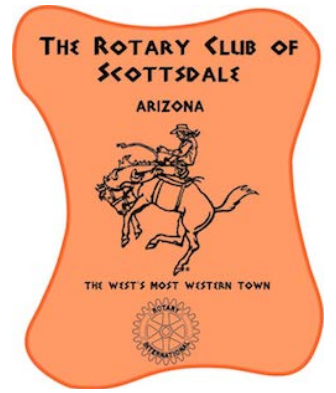

Our speaker today is Alan Mulally, the former President, Chief Executive Officer, and member of the Board of Directors of Ford Motor Company from September 2006 to June 2014. Prior to joining Ford, Mulally served as Executive Vice President of The Boeing Company and President and Chief Executive Officer of Boeing Commercial Airplanes. He also served as President of Boeing Information, Space & Defense Systems. He is currently a member of Alphabet Inc.'s (GOOG) Board of Directors and sits on its Audit Committee in addition to being on the Board of Directors of Carbon3D, Inc.

Mulally holds Bachelor and Master of Science degrees in aeronautical and astronautical engineering from the University of Kansas, and earned a Master's in management from M.I.T. as a 1982 Alfred P. Sloan fellow.

## Max's Message

Last week Kent shared insightful information on current trends in hacking and phishing online. He cautioned Club members that the "bad guys" have gotten very sophisticated and professional in fooling people into transferring money from businesses and individuals into their own bank accounts. The "bad guys" have moved beyond awkward emails with poor English, to emails that capture the writing style of the person they are imitating, easily done after cracking weak passwords on email accounts.
