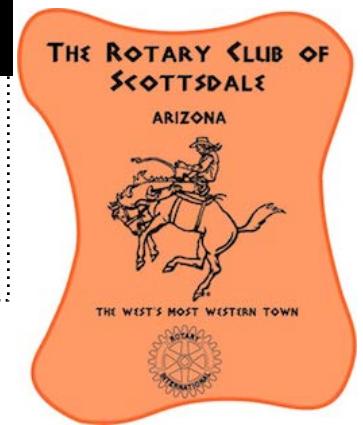

Today

Our speaker today is the Scottsdale Chief of Police, Alan G. Rodbell. Chief Rodbell earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminology from the University of Maryland and continued on to earn a Masters of Education degree in Counseling from Western Maryland College. He is also a graduate of the FBI National Academy, 177th Session, in Quantico, Virginia.

Chief Rodbell began his law enforcement career in 1976 as a Patrol Officer with the Montgomery County Department of Police in Rockville, Maryland. He was subsequently promoted to the ranks of investigator, sergeant, lieutenant, captain and was named Assistant Chief of Police in 1996. He held that position in Montgomery County until 2002, when he relocated to Arizona and accepted the position of Deputy Chief of Police, Investigative Services Bureau, with the Scottsdale Arizona Police Department. In April 2003 he was promoted to Chief of Police at Scottsdale.
