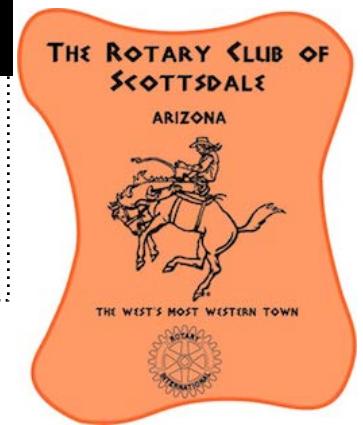

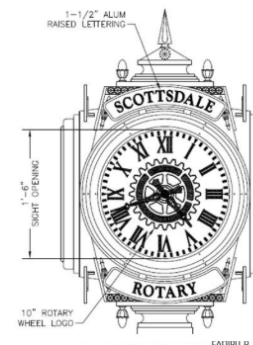
These are both excellent opportunities to not only talk with the students, but also give them the practice and practical experience of interviewing.
