

Ford holds an M.B.A. from Duke University's Fuqua School of Business as well as a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from The Georgia Institute of Technology. He is also a certified Six Sigma Blackbelt and Shingijutzu Lean Expert.

Max's Message

Rotary has been doing good in the world for decades. But how it does it has changed. The focus is now on SUSTAINABILITY. It is sort of like the old adage: Give a person a fish and they will eat for a day; give a person a fishing pole, teach them to use it and they will eat for a lifetime.
