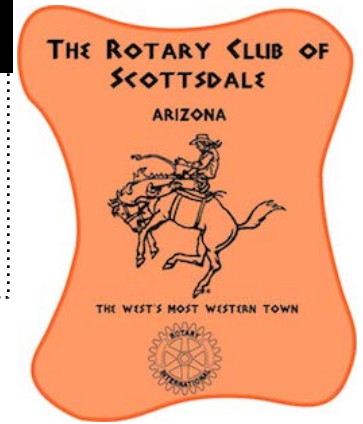

2014 is racing to the finish line and with that are deadlines for directing your tax money as you see appropriate. Here are some options to consider:
