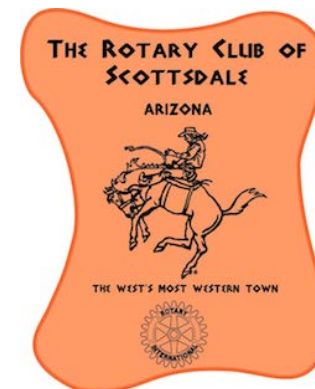

Our speaker today is the Honorable Roberto Rodriguez, Consul General of Mexico. Born in Cuernavaca, Morelos, in 1954, Consul General Rodriguez graduated from Law School at the Autonomous University of Morelos and began his career in the Mexican Foreign Service in 1977. In 1989, he obtained his Master's Degree in Criminal Science at the University of Valle de Bravo. In 1991 he was promoted to the rank of Minister in the Mexican Foreign Service, and in November 2002 he was promoted to the rank of Ambassador.

He has had several appointments both overseas and at the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Honorable Roberto Rodriguez has been stationed in the capacity of Consul General of Mexico in Phoenix, AZ since June of 2013.
