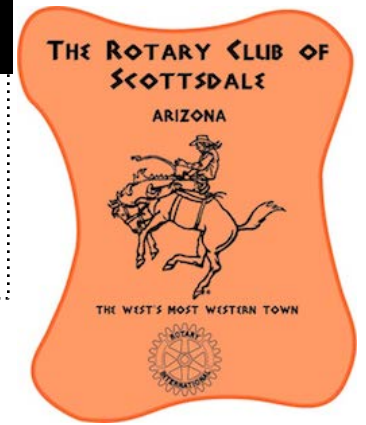

Our speaker today is Dr. Michael Crow, 16th President of Arizona State University. Under his leadership ASU has established more than a dozen new transdisciplinary schools and large-scale research initiatives.

Crow received his PhD in Public Administration (Science and Technology Policy) from the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs, Syracuse University. He was previously executive vice provost of Columbia University, where he also was professor of science and technology policy in the School of International and Public Affairs.

Born in 1955 in San Diego, California, Crow is the son of a U.S. Navy sailor.

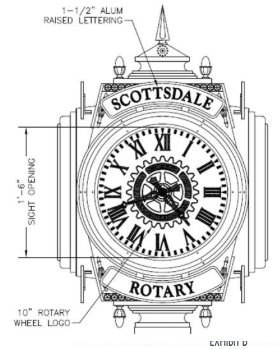
