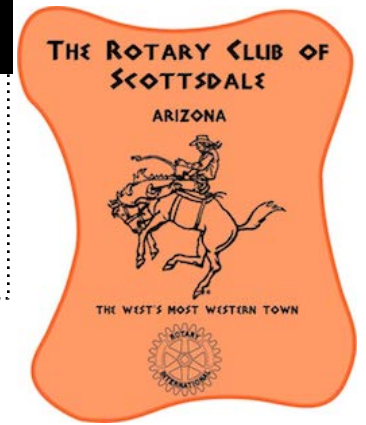

Speaker: Douglas Price - FBI SAC of Phx Division

Today

Our speaker today is Douglas Price from the FBI Phoenix Division. Prior to being named Special Agent in Charge, he served as chief of the Employee Development and Selection Program Section in the Human Resources Division at FBI Headquarters in Washington, D.C. His work has been extensive since he first reported in 1996 at the Las Cruces Resident Agency out of the Albuquerque Division. From there, he was transferred to the Los Angeles Division to serve on the Violent Crime and Major Offenders-Cargo Theft Task Force.

Other temporary duty assignments have included being on the Investigative Team at the 2002 Olympics in Salt Lake City, logistics and investigations in Baghdad, and the Logistics Team at the 2004 Olympics in Athens, Greece. In 2004, Mr. Price joined the Joint Terrorism Task Force Counterterrorism Threat Squad. He was promoted in February 2006 to supervisor of a Counterterrorism Squad and program coordinator for Domestic Terrorism and International Terrorism.

In February 2008, Mr. Price was selected as a team leader assistant inspector in the Inspection Division at FBI Headquarters. Mr. Price was promoted in September 2009 to assistant special agent in charge in the Los Angeles Criminal Division, which included the Civil Rights, Organized Crime, and Violent Crime Programs.
