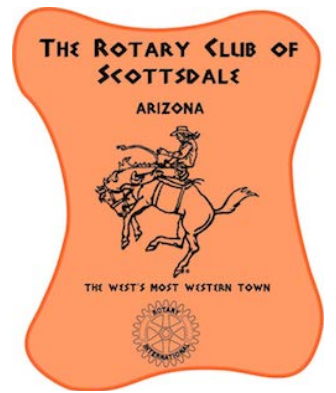

5. Continue to be known for its great programs and terrific luncheons.

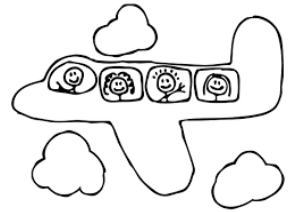
