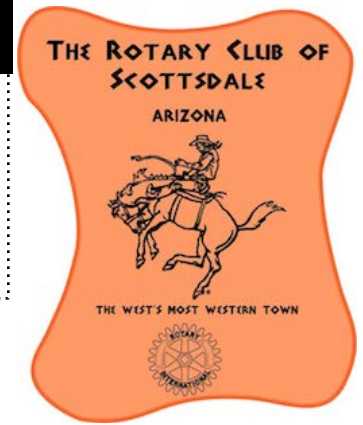

The Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona (TRVFA) Scholarship Recipient Update

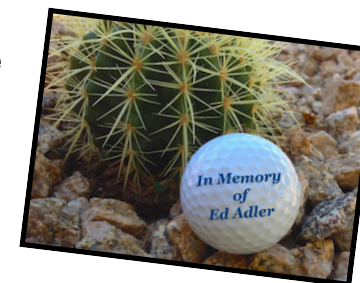
One of our scholarship recipients, Bently Parise, accepted a job offer from Honeywell in their engineering department immediately after completing the course we sponsored him to attend.
