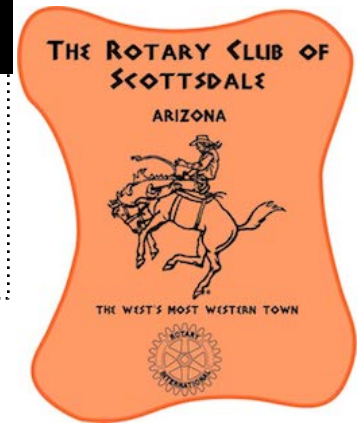

Today's Speaker: Bill Montgomery, Maricopa County Attorney

Today

Our speaker today is Maricopa County Attorney, Bill Montgomery. He was first elected Maricopa County Attorney in a Special Election in 2010 and re-elected in 2012 on a pledge to fight crime, honor victims' rights, and protect and strengthen our community. As a West Point Graduate, decorated Gulf War Veteran, former Deputy County Attorney, and a professional prosecutor, he has dedicated his personal and professional life to serving others.

Bill earned his J.D. from ASU's College of Law, graduating Magna Cum Laude and receiving the Order of the Coif. As a prosecutor with the Maricopa County Attorney's Office, he quickly gained a reputation as an aggressive prosecutor, later serving as a Bureau Chief of the Auto Theft Bureau, which recorded a 35% drop in auto theft under his leadership.

I participated in the Youth Salute interviews for the first time last Thursday night at Chaparral High School along with a dozen or so fellow Rotarians. As you may remember, this is a joint venture with the Scottsdale Airpark Rotary Club and this process identifies 3-4 high school juniors to represent the entire state of Arizona at the Town Meeting on Tomorrow this summer in St. Louis, Missouri. About thirty students were interviewed that night by four teams. The winners receive an all expense paid trip to the Gateway to the West and have the opportunity to hear dynamic national speakers and "mingle" with the future leaders of tomorrow. Many thanks to Co-Chairs, Mary Blank and Mike Savastio, for their leadership of this great program.
