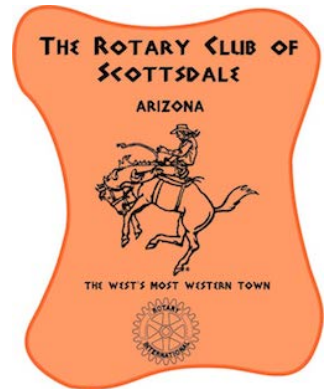

Max's Message

Waging peace in our cities and in the world was the subject of the first of five globally located RI Presidential Conferences. This one was held in California last weekend with 1,500 Rotarians attending.

From the conference I gleaned that Peace is considered more than the absence of conflict: it is the absence of violence plus respect for one's neighbors.

Peace is not just an international issue, it is also a local issue. Rotary Peace Fellows are working in the Middle East with refugees. Yet, they are also working in U.S. cities to reduce gang wars and local crime. Highlighted was the observation that usually communities consider Human Trafficking as not existing locally: but it is often a hidden secret in nearly every community. (Watch for our program on May 16th on this topic.)

A sub-theme of the conference was that one person can make a difference in any such Rotary effort. Would you like to become involved?
