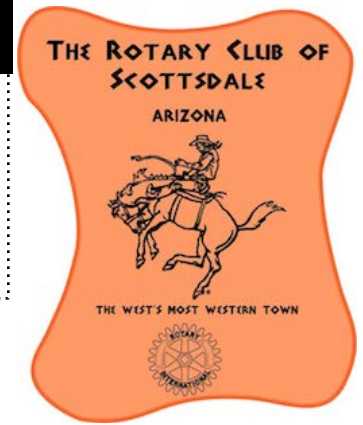

By the way, did you notice who won the first ever college football playoff championship? THE Ohio State University...Go Bucks...

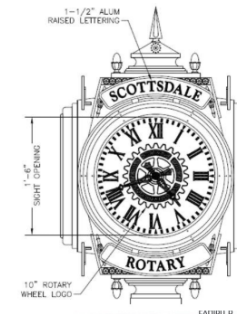
