New Club Attends District Assembly by Kleeberger, Bruce

David Hothi, Mike Labadie, Jeff Hector and Dennis Williams reported on their outstanding experience at the District Assembly held April 12 the the Kwantlen Campus in Surrey.

Jeff reported that the seminars he planned to attend were "shifted" and he attended **Rotary Extension** by Gene Vickers. It was regarding the formation of new clubs and he was able to contribute significantly to this discussion. He also attended the **Meeting Program** seminare along with Winston Conyers and Dennis Williams. Specific ideas including: Student of the Month guest speakers. Stateside, the clubs appear to focus on community involvement.

Mike attended the **Secretaries** seminar and from that he felt the club was adequately being served by it's secretary. He also attended the **Foundation Seminar** which reinforced his understanding of the network of grants which are available. including Individual and District Simplified Grants.

Bonnie felt from her seminars that the Communities will support clubs which do work in their communities. Specific program discussed included **Literacy**

- Monthly book distributions to yound people in cooperation with public and private agencies
- Read to me program to assist inmates of correctional institutions communicate with their families

Bonnie also attended a **Public Relations** seminar discussing RI News, publicity oportunites and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation contribution to the PolioPlus progrm and the good publicity coming from that. Also, bicycle recycling, "dress for success" workshops, newspaper distribution to school, winter coat collections and Miracle League baseball for handicapped persons (Munro Club) were other Community Services concepts.

Dennis attended the **Sergeant at Arms** seminar and declared us "fortunate". He said that initially new clubs commonly use SA funds to support the club managment but more established clubs use them for imaginative projects in their community. He also attended a seminar on **Youth Exchange** which has some difficulties because of the various standards of education between countries. Participants are typically 17 - 19 years of age and are from Asia and Europe.

David attended seminar on **GSE**. Participants are 25 - 40 years of age and often of various professions. In addition his rport of the **Community Service** Seminar included public school dictonaries and an impression that many clubs rely on dinners with auctions as excellent fund raising methods. 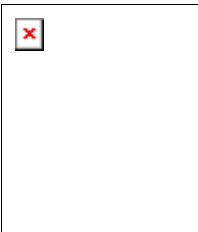
