### The Land Conservancy of British Columbia by Kleeberger, Bruce

At it's regular meeting of 12 August, the Rotary Club of White Rock Peninsula was pleased to welcome Mr. John Keller (TLC) who is it's local representative.



The Conservancy is 11 years old and is headquartered in Victoria. It's slogan is "**Speical Places, Forever, For Everyone**". It is a non-profit, charitable land trust, modelled on the National Trust in the UK.

It's approach is non-confrontational, partnership focused and specializes in direct acquisitions of sites of historical and environmental importance. It seeks to make arrangements for conservation of properties which are to the benefit of the public, governments and land owners. To protect the interests in the properties, conservation covenants are in place and stewardship to improve and rehabilitate, as needed, is important.

Currently over 300 properties and 120,000 acres are protected. Examples given include unique tracts of land in watersheds, remote locations, special habitats as well as properties important to the cultural heritage of the province. The TLC has an operating budget of \$2 Million and 800 volunteers. The intetntion is for the membership to grow from it's current 7,500 members to 18,000 at which time it will be self sustaining on memberships alone.

"GolFun" Tournament coming up on **August 22nd** at the Surrey Golf Club.
