The wife said, 'You should do it because you get up first, and then we don't have to wait as long to get our coffee.

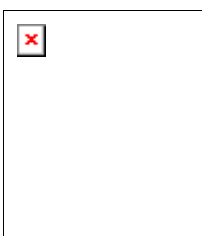
