Hello everybody, in regards to our trip to Cancun, here are the rates for the same hotel we stayed at last year, Gran Caribe Real.

Being high season this time, the rates are higher this year.

All the rooms are all inclusive (taxes included), in USD, and have ocean view.

Below I have translated the rates. You will see they are per person, per night.
