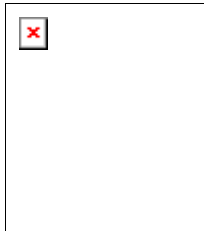

February 20: Grosvenor

Michael Ward of Grosvenor Canada presented the proposed development being considered for the area north of 32nd Avenue between Highway 99 and 152 Street...



Michael is the Development Manager for the project and also on hand were David Fraser, PEng, and Andrew Pottinger with of Pottinger and Associates, Community Relations.

Grosvenor is active in Surrey with it's Boulevard Development along King George Highway and the South Point Exchange project. They have identified a need for higher density "boutique type" of development. They acquired the site (called the "Village" site) 2 years ago. They feel there is a shortage of small condominium and mixed retail with residential accomodation.

The site comprises 15 acres and will have 400 condominiums, most over small retail shops, with 20 town homes. No part of the project will be over 4 stories.

The Developer proposes to upgrade local roadways with improvements worth \$3-\$4.5 million. It is a \$200 million project with \$20 million to be contributed to local improvements which includes development cost charges. The residential portion will be sold but Grosvenor will retain and lease the commercial portion.
