Visiting student Mariana Cerqueira from Sao Paulo Brazil was introduced by visiting Elaine Baxter of the Peace Arch Club. She will return for a more complete presentation before she leaves Canada.

Mr. Jay Besteman, a visiting Rotarian, was our guesste speaker and hespoke passionately about his expeerinces while living in South Africa and of the rich history of the country.

South Africa has been settled by Europeans for over 500 years. Dutch sailors, from the most powerful country in the world at that time saw the maritime importance of the country. They encountered the native Bushmen and Hotentots and later the Zulu tribes immitrated from the north.

British domination later left the families of the Dutch immigrants, the Boers, in concentration camps. The British policies left nations devided in such a way that civil wars were inevitable.

South Africa has 7 deep water harbours. At times when the Suez passage has been blocked, up to 14,000 ship have sailed around the Cape annually.

In 1994, the political changes in the country meant replacment of many white African officials with black Africans. The country continues to struggle with many economic and social challenges.
