PDG Dave Robinson was the guest speaker at the meeting of July 8. After many inspirational words of wisdom, he presented Paul Harris Fellowships to the members in attendance.

PDG Robinson posed the question "Why belong to Rotary" and suggested a basic need to be "Working through Rotary to build a better world". Why be involved in Rotary? "Because we care...the children of the world are in need". Rotarians of the world are carrying the "blazing torch of service"

Mentorship of new members is key to retention. The story was told of the "member who never came back". He attended meetings, made himself available and tried to be included....but by failing to include and involve the member....he never came back.



Introduced in 1984, this program aims to advance international understanding among Rotarians. It provides Rotarians with the opportunity to form personal contacts and make long-lasting friendships while exploring different areas of the world.
