Peace Arch Hospital Foundation Featured

- **Rotarian Sandy Wightman** of the Peace Arch Hospital Foundation presented a summary of the Foundations history and current projects. Sandy is a member of the Semiahmoo Club.

Sandy is the Chair of the Board of Directors of the Foundation. The hospital was first opened, and was the first in Surrey, in 1954. It's catchment area is 90,000 residents. The Foundations partners include the Peace Arch Auxillary, White Rock South Surrey Foundation, Fraser Health, federal and provincial governments and some local Rotary Clubs.

Some of our hospitals vital statistics Sandy reported on are:

- there are 37,000 hospital visits/year
- 12,000 of those visits come from patients who live north of Hwy 10
- there are 2,000 surgeries requiring overnight stay/yr
- there are 3,000 day surgeries/yr
- there are 1,000 admissions/yr

The Foundation projects include: 56 new beds on the 5th floor, recently opened, the upgrades to the the Mel Edwards Cntr in Centennial Park, a new MRI and expansion of the hospital into the new acquired land along 16th Avenue and next to the emergency entrance.

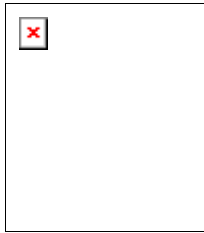
celebrations. It will be at the Star of the Sea Hall, with a live band, dress casual for only \$60 per person.

Professionals for goodwill exchange

Rotary club members of WhiteRockPeninsula are seeking four outstanding professionals to visit Ecuador in April, 2009 as part of the Group Study Exchange program of The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International.

Through the program, teams of young professionals from two different countries exchange visits. For four to six weeks, team members experience the way of life, customs, and vocational practices of another country, while sharing information about their homeland.

The purpose of the Group Study Exchange program is to promote international understanding and goodwill through personal connection. While abroad, team members stay in Rotarians' homes and have the opportunity to meet their professional counterparts. They also give presentations to Rotary clubs and other groups about their home country.

The Rotary Foundations pays for round-trip airfare, and the Rotary club members in the host country provide meals, lodging, and group travel in their district. Team members pay for personal and incidental expenses.

Young adults between the ages of 25 and 40 who are interested in applying should be employed full-time in a business of profession. Applicants must live or be employed in district 5050 which encompasses the Fraser Valley in British Columbia, Canada and the North-Western state of Washington, USA.
