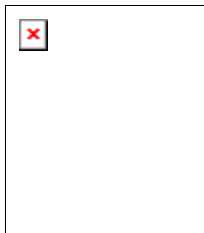
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Attendance and YOU!

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Attendance has always been an important consideration for Rotary members. It is how membership is nurtured and Clubs remain vital. It is the reason why Rotary through out the world enjoys growth of it's membership in a time when most service organizations are experiencing declining participation (our community is certainly no exception). Many members are very careful to be sure their "100% Attendance" is maintained.



That doesn't mean that you will make every meeting. Many options are available to "makeup" for a missed meeting including:

- attendance at another Rotary or Rotaract club meeting (even showing up for a meeting and then finding out it isn't happening counts!!!)
- attendance at board or committee meeting of which the Rotarian is a member
- attendance and participation at a club service project or event
- Rotary website on-line makeup of at least 30 minutes duration.

So, with so many choices **everyone can be a 100% member!**

Rotary imposes a few conditions on meetings and membership however including:

- no club is permitted to miss more than 2 meetings out of 52 each year (which is why we even meet sometimes on holidays when they fall on a meeting night).
- to be eligible to be claimed as a makeup, an activity must be completed within a period "**14 days before or after**" the meeting being made up
- attendance is to be recorded only for a member who attends at least 60% of a meeting: this includes makeups!

Help yourself, your club and your President as we achieve 100% attendance for the worlds only 100% Paul Harris Society Club!
