Gordon spoke about his past speaking engagements worldwide and how he came to realize that all affective change comes from the "political will" to make a difference. To affect political will he stated that it is necessary to target what you wish to achieve, aim for that goal and speak of it in terms of success of achievement. Gordon spoke of ACT BC and its' responsibility to create cultural change. To date this cultural change has been demonstrated in many ways; under the banner of the Healthy Living Alliance previously competing large not for profits now work together for the health of British Columbians, all provincial Ministries have the responsibility to promote healthy lifestyles while planning new projects, several employers are developing workplace wellness models which will lead to ACT BC health employer certification, and the World Health Organization is currently assessing BC for Best Practices in health care promotion. On a more personal level Gordon addressed the every day adjustments each of us can make to improve our lifestyle ensuring that we have quality of life to the end of our lives.

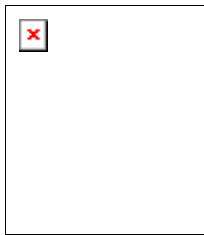
