Guest Speaker - Brian Nosko

SmartCentres is Canada's largest retail developer and operator specializing in large-scale, value-oriented shopping centres. The company is currently managing and developing over 200 SmartCentres

Brian Nosko, Vice President of Leasing, Western Region, has been with Smartcentres for 3 years and has lived in South Surrey for 21 years. Brian told us that Smartcentres is the development arm of Walmart and that their company brought Walmart into Canada. Their Grandview Corners project includes Walmart and Home Depot. Future Shop will open in May

There are 700,000 square feet in their current development project and there will be 1.2 million sq. ft. in a few more years including the Superstore which is to be built in the area although it is not part of the Smartcentres project. Part of the development at Grandview Corners includes a LifestyleVillage which will include H&M and Indigo. Indigo will open on April 17th. The LifestyleVillage will be the biggest unenclosed shopping centre in BC. Smartcentres includes green initiatives including bioswales and recycling and attractive gardens.

When asked about access to the shopping plaza, Brian said that the overpass and 24th and the 99 has been retrofitted so that on and off ramps can be added in the future.
