Mayor Forster Adresses Club *by Kleeberger, Bruce*

Mayor Judy Forster brought greetings from White Rock City Council and optimism for the projects of Rotary and the City.



Mayor Forster presented more information for the Club regarding the "Spirit Square" or "Spirit Plaza" project as she would prefer it be called, planned for the White Rock waterfront. The loss of more than 30 parking places has raised interest in rethinking the parking for the area, including the possibility of such initiatives as **valet parking** and a **parking garage** behind the Boathouse Restaurant as well as **parking passes for non White Rock residents**. A Mayor's tax has been struck.

She also spoke about the City's discussions with the Semiahmoo Band and City of Surrey regarding the extension of the promenade to the Peace Arch Park and Crescent Beach.

The Mayor, as a Rotarian, is very proud of the Rotary contribution in the past the development of the promenade, and the Coast Capital Playhouse. She also spoke about the Rotary contribution to the Wellness Centre being developed in Centennial Park.

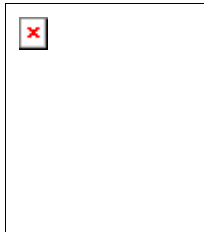
