### H4H in Guatemala - 20 May 2008

PDG Jim Follows introduced special guests Dr. Mike Morton and Nurse Cindy Masaro to the Club. Following a video presentation of their project **Health for Humanity (H4H)** they answered many questions from the floor. H4H is a "Canadian-based volunteer organization providing quality medical care, equipment and supplies to the poor of Guatemala and other developing countries". [Click here](#) for more details



60% of Guatemalans live in poverty, 27% in extreme poverty. %0% of Guatmelans are indogenous Mayans with little or no access to medical care. The Antigua project is carried out in a hospital where over 120 procedures are completed. \$17,000 approximately is raised towards the cost of patient care. Of these, 32 are cleft lip/palate repair procedures.

**Gary McIntosh** led the club in a 50/50 coin toss. **Dr. Mike Morton** was the lucky winner of \$40 which he promptly donated back to the club. Thanks Dr. Mike!

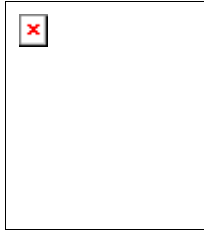
### Club Site Sponsors
