He expressed concern about the casualness of attitude he now finds towards Remembrance Day. He told of Bible lessons to illustrate the historical importance of remembering and then reminded us that 20 million combatants died in WW 1 and 2, and 40 million civilians perished. Of the "enemy, 5 million Germans died. 10 million Russian combatants died. Also it was a physically and organizationally challenging time for countries. With changes in communications technologies, conflicts world wide are now brought into our "living rooms" in real time. It is truly a time to "never forget them".

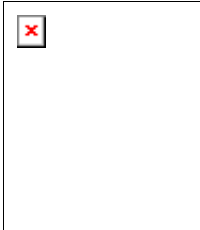

### District Governor Larry Stinson wants you to know:

**Candidates for District Governor 2011/2012** - The District Nominating Committee will soon be considering candidates for the position of District Governor for the 2011-2012 Rotary Year. Clubs are invited to recommend qualified candidates to the Nominating Committee in accordance with the following procedure:

1. the recommendation must be in the form of a resolution adopted at a regular meeting of the club, certified by the club secretary, and forwarded to PDG Harv Jubie, Chair of the District Nominating Committee, at 6717-45th Place NEMarysville, WA, USA 98270, by the deadline of January 31, 2009.
2. a club may only recommend one of it's own members.

3. candidates must meet the following qualifications:

- must be a member in good standing of a functioning club in the District
- will have been a member of one or more Rotary clubs for at least 7 years at the time of taking office
- must have served as a club president for a full term or if a charter president for the full balance of the term from the date of charter (minimum 6 months)
- must be willing and able to fulfil the duties and responsibilities of District Governor (see the attached list of District Governor Responsibilities to provide to a prospective candidate).
