Marg Fraser from Fraser Health introduced us to a new residential care facility called CareLife Fleetwood. This is a 191-bed residential care facility, which provides many new and innovative amenities for seniors in residential care.

Carelife Fleetwood looks like an attractive condominium development. It is divided into 24 bed sections or 'houses', which are named for trees. Attention has been paid to many details in an effort to ensure seniors are cared for in the best environment possible.

Most residents have private rooms, which are equipped with a ceiling lift; rooms also have wheelchair-accessible private bathrooms. The corridors are spacious and bright. Interior courtyards provide a secure environment for residents to relax outdoors. One of the courtyards even has a greenhouse for plant and flower cultivation.

To make the environment more homelike, all meals are prepared on site in a state-of-the-art fresh food kitchen. Marg showed us pictures of the hobby room, living room and family entertainment facility, which can be booked for special events.


She emphasized that the new approach to end-of-life care was respectful of abilities and intellect. The focus was on developing meaningful relationship with residents. Staff allow residents to have as much choice as possible over life needs and support these needs in whichever way they can.
