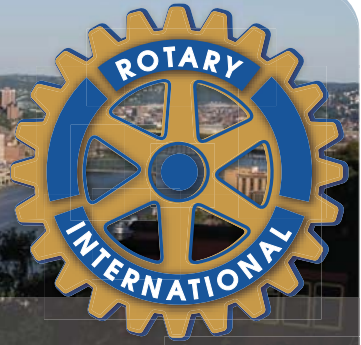
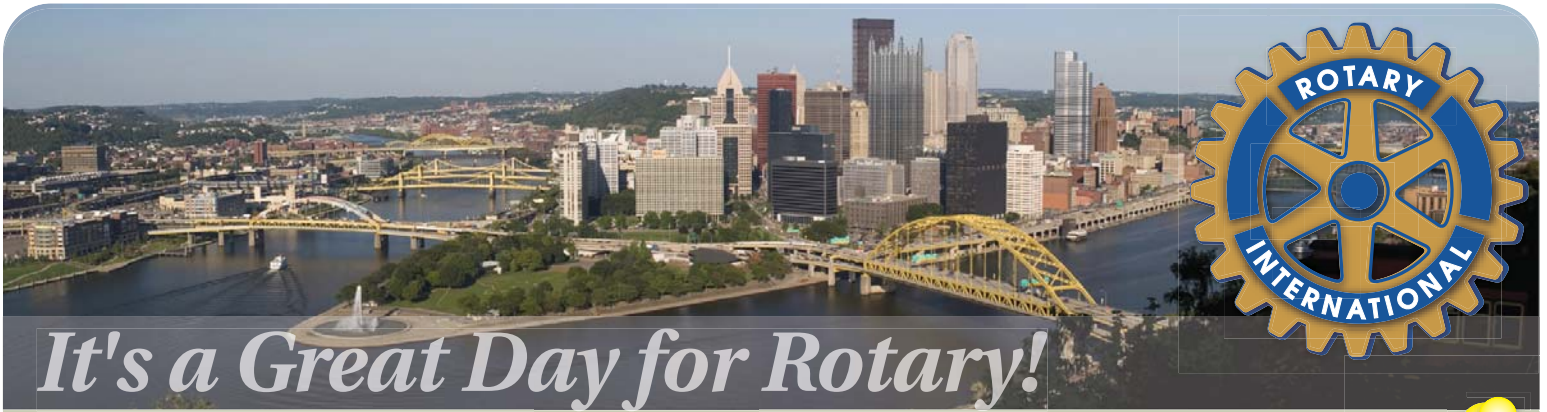
The meeting then adjourned with the reciting of the Four Way Test.
