Kirk Chambers then presented the Secretary's report including welcoming guests and announcing club anniversaries. Veteran Sally Mizerak posted 15 years as a Rotarian!!!

New-comer Ron Garrett was then introduced to the team by one of the locker room veteran favorites, P.K. Weston. Welcome to the team Ron!

Robin Zoufalik then presented our speaker of the day, Bruce Klein, Founder and Curator of the Photo Antiquities Museum. Mr. Klein discussed the photographic history of Pittsburgh, the USA and the world. As a side note, Mr. Klein's son Ben was a past Pittsburgh Rotary Club scholarship winner. Here are some highlights of the presentation:

- The world's first photograph was taken in 1839
- That image was on copper, the exposure time for the photo was 30 minutes and the graphic was developed in a box with open mercury
- The museum has, what they believe to be, the oldest photo of Pittsburgh from Mount Washington which was taken in 1896
- 3-D technology dates back to 1890 with side-by-side camera. This camera had dual lenses, placed 3 1/2 inches apart just like the human eyes which creates the 3-d effect.
- For more than 70 years, photography was a terribly dangerous profession due to the chemicals and developing processes.
- Back in the 1800's, before electricity, photography studios were built with skylights in the ceiling to assist with the photography lighting.
- The museum is currently working on expansion plans, including a new location.
