President Andy then introduced us to our speaker of the day, Yuval Zaliouk, International Businessman and Chronicler of Israeli Events. His topic was titled, "The History of the Middle East Conflict"

In getting started with his presentation, we found that that Mr. Zaliouk was an orchestra conductor in Toledo and in Haifa, Israel. Mr. Zaliouk discussed what he believes is the "ultimate" basis for the Middle East conflict. In general, he believes the conflict is based in the non recognition of Israel as the "homeland of the Jews" by the surrounding Arab countries.

Mr. Zaliouk pointed out specific charters, doctrines and resolutions put forth by the UN, Arab States and other entities since 1917. In his opinion, these documents show proof of action and non action as well as the strength and finances of the Arab oil nations that continue to prohibit this recognition.

Mr. Zaliouk, in his words, tried to put 4,000 years of history into 30 minutes for our presentation. We thank him for his time and for traveling from Toledo to present.
