- Mr. Goin explained the differences between the PGA group and the USGA.
- Most revenue from golf outings that you see on TV goes to charity
- PGA plans on donating a minimum of \$500,000 to Pittsburgh's First Tee charity at the end of this event
- Professional golfers pay their own travel and accommodation expenses for tournaments
- This year's event will have Greg Norman, Fred Couples, Tom Watson, Fuzzy Zeller and Arnold Palmer involved
- Price for a single day ticket is \$25
- Mr. Goin is here to recruit volunteers, spectators as well as sponsors
- Volunteer positions included Marshals, office help, sign holders, etc.
- The Economic impact of this 7-day event is approximately \$25M

At the end of his presentation, Mr. Goin presented Andy with an autographed golf flag. It's signed by Fred Couples. Most were excited about it but Andy was unfamiliar with who Fred Couples is. Andy says HIS specialty is Putt-Putt Golf!
