Meeting adjourned on time...as usual!



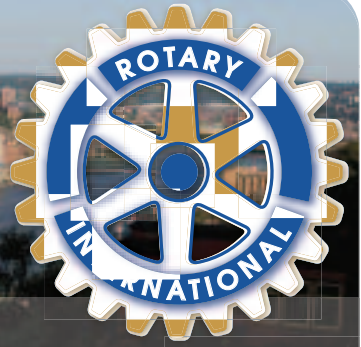

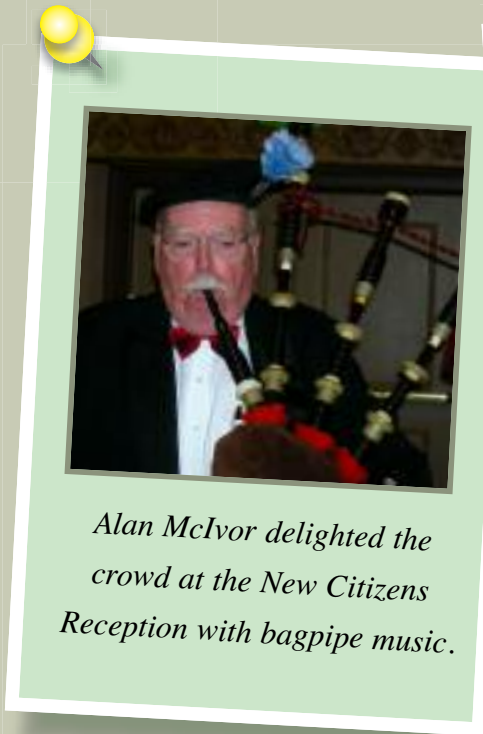
