First, if you attended the Kivi Bernhard event, please remember to follow-up with your guests and encourage them to attend a meeting, learn more about Rotary, and join! Also note that the New Citizens Reception will not be held this month. Camilla von Gayl, one of our exchange students from Berlin, Germany, was introduced to the club. Camilla is living with a family in Highland Park and attending Oakland Catholic. She will be attending our meetings once a month for the next year. Please be sure to extend a warm welcome and make her feel at home.

During her 3 Minutes of Fame **Demetria Pappas**, Co-Founder of Mother May I, talked about Team River Runner, an organization that promotes the health and healing of wounded veterans through aquatic sports like kayaking. She learned about Team River Runner while visiting another Rotary Club in St. John and was so inspired by their mission that she encouraged the Pittsburgh Social Exchange to raise \$5,000 to support their cause.

Robin Zoufalik introduced our speaker, Cliff Milowicki, Vice President and Partner with Alliance Physical Therapy and Performance Centers. A fellow Rotarian from the McMurray Club, Mr. Milowicki was born and raised in Pittsburgh. He went to Ohio

University for his undergraduate studies and then to Thomas Jefferson University for a master's in physical therapy. After several years in practice, he taught a course at Wheeling Jesuit University which reinvigorated his passion for helping people heal and improve their performance. Milowicki then launched a staffing business for small health care providers, worked at Mayview State Hospital, and founded his latest venture, Alliance Physical Therapy and Performance Centers. Originally founded as an outpatient physical therapy center, Alliance responded to the challenges presented by the healthcare market in Pittsburgh – which is dominated by large companies that are both service and insurance providers – by expanding its service offerings and tailoring its business model to be one that limits reliance on insurance company reimbursements. In addition to traditional physical therapy, Alliance now offers specialized training for athletes and scientifically-based weight loss solutions.

Through a partnership with Titleist, one of the world's biggest names in golf equipment, Alliance provides golfers with custom evaluations and performance training. Recreational and professional athletes alike have benefited from the program. Top local player Kevin Shields and Missie Berteotti, past winner of the LPGA tour, are among their clients. After lots of Q&A from the audience, Mr. Milowicki concluded by encouraging other small business owners to consider forming strategic partnerships in order to drive growth.
