President Ray Amelio called to order the meeting of the Rotary Club of Pittsburgh founded in _____. (If you just excitedly shouted out, "1910" look around and apologize to those around you.) The club was chartered in 1911 and is the _____th club in the world.

Today's invocation was given by Linda Fischer. James Gourlay led the pledge of allegiance and then he and Jim Hall led us in song, "God Bless America." (____ is the number of years Jim Hall has been a Rotarian.)

In President Ray's remarks, he noted that 60-year member, Cal Stuckeman, has suffered a stroke. A card was passed around for signatures and wishes. During "Good News" Sam Reich asked that everyone acknowledge Jack Miller's hard work in pulling together the latest Rotary Day with the Pirates.

Kirk Chambers then welcomed lots of guests of Rotarians, a few visiting Rotarians and guests of the speaker. (____ is the name of Kirk's company.)

New member, Dan Zangrilli, then gave his 3-minutes of fame. He talked about his radio broadcasting career as the Pirates pre/post-game show announcer for 93.7FM "The Fan" and his Farmer's Insurance Agency. (____ is Dan's broadcast partner.)

Thanks goodness we were running early because our speaker the Hon. David M. Walker had a lot to say. Dave is the Founder and CEO of the Comeback America Initiative. He brought in a "Debt Burden" clock that was as bright as the sun. (____ SPF was the level of sunscreen donned by the front row.)

He was speaking on behalf of an issue oriented bus tour campaign that is led by the Comeback America Initiative. The tour will stop in over a dozen states, bringing national attention to the economic and fiscal challenges facing our nation. The tour is fact-based, non-partisan and non-ideological. It focuses on the tough choices we face and sensible, non-partisan solutions that can achieve bipartisan support and restore fiscal sanity.

An overview of his presentation is:

Our nation's fiscal challenge is much worse and growing at a much faster rate than politicians are willing to admit.

The National Debt Clock significantly understates the severity of our federal financial challenge because it only represents the total current amount of U.S. public and intra-governmental debt. The magnitude of the financial challenge facing the U.S. is better represented by the federal government's total liabilities (e.g., publicly held debt, unfunded military/civilian pensions and retiree health obligations, environmental liabilities), unfunded social insurance promises (e.g., Social Security and Medicare), and a range of other federal commitments and contingencies (e.g., Federal National Mortgage Association, Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation). These figures are the basis for CAI's new Burden Barometer, which provides a much better measure of the enormity of our federal financial challenge.
