Wow! I actually made it to a meeting. The meeting was opened by **Richard Dixon's** invocation followed by the Pledge and song, "Zip a Dee Doo Dah!" by **Dick**

**Hodgdon and Jim Hall.**

President **Andy Dlinn** gave a few remarks. Then he introduced Secretary **Margaret DeLeeuw** who welcomed the guests.

**Al Wells** then gave a presentation about Caring Habits. Caring Habits is a program about changing attitudes in students toward work and school. Al showed a short video over viewing Caring Habits' activities.

Rotary is involved by supporting the Caring Habit of the month and teaching it to the 7&8 grade students at one of the City of Pittsburgh schools, South Hills School. Al is looking for volunteers to participate in this one time per month. A class takes about 60 minutes so it's about a 2-hour commitment.

**Dick Hodgdon** introduced today's speaker **Rich Stinson**, President of Power Distribution Operations for Eaton Corporations.

Eaton is a global company whose forte is power management systems: Buildings, utilities, machinery to name a few markets.

Some notes about Eaton from the presentation.

- Founded in 1911
- 70,000 employees
- #1 in North America in power distribution
- 55% of sales come from outside United States and this business continues to grow.
- Eaton has been recognized as one of the top ethical companies in the world
- Eaton is working in green technology including electric cars; more technology in electric cars than GE
- In addition to just designing components that get installed, the Eaton company designs, installs and maintains and optimizes power applications
- The company does :
  - Power distribution products
  - Power quality
  - Power control and automation
  - Power monitoring
  - Energy Management Services
- The company is also involved in alternative energy sources such as nuclear, solar and wind
- Electric transportation \$400m market over next 4 years. Eaton is constructing power stations for electric cars
- Total corporation is \$13.7 billion USD
- The US market is approximately \$3.7B

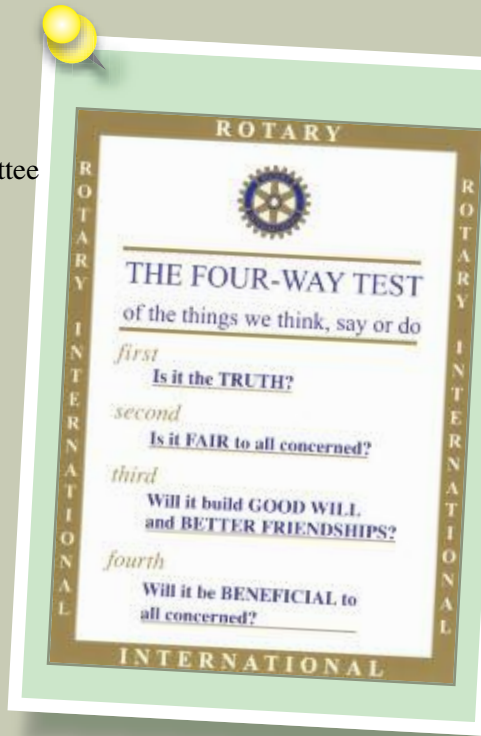
