Mark! Bohl program, classification speech.

Dr. Bud Grove being honored tonight with a \$2000 scholarship from an anonymous donor (who was a past student Rotarian). Mark studied in Illinois, was going to be a dentist, however, instead of waiting a year to apply to dental school, he went to Chiropractic School... and found his calling! He always wanted to work with his hands and help people. He never had a "chiropractic miracle" but his Dad did. He came to Mount Horeb to Study with Dr. Grove and occasionally attended the Gonstead seminars as well. Dr. Grove hired him as an associate chiropractor in 1980. Grove died in 1984 and Mark bought the practice at that time. Dr. Grove was

a Rotarian and would bring flags from all over the world where he taught.

Chiropractic has only been a profession since 1895. Mark started in 1980. He talked about difficulties of Chiropractors with the AMA who tried to undermine the profession.

80% of the nervous system is sensory, and 80% of the sensory nerves are around the spine. A dysfunction/fixation of a spinal joint will affect those nerves, causing pain, spasms and inflammation in that area. Treating the dysfunction corrects those symptoms, which medically would be treated with pain meds, anti inflammatories and muscle relaxers.
