Rob is on the Wisconsin Board of the American Cancer Society

His wife has stage IV breast cancer and will be swimming all five lakes in Madison to spread awareness of metastatic breast cancer, a form that only receives 2% of all breast cancer funding.

Rob had 3 points he wanted us to take away:

1. Think of cancer as a terrorist... constantly changing
2. Leading Causes of Cancer 30% tobacco, 30% Adult diet/obesity 40% other factors
Leading cancer deaths are lung/bronchus in both men and women.
3. 30% of breast cancer will recur or metastasize
