#### THIS WEEK: THE STATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MAINE

This week, we will hear from RIchard Pattenaude, Chancellor of the University of Maine system. Dr. Pattenaude will provide us with an update on the state of the University system during this period of high demand, low funding, and constant budget pressure.

Richard L. Pattenaude became chancellor of the University of Maine System in July 2007, after serving for sixteen years as president of the University of Southern Maine.

Prior to that, he served for five years as vice president for academic affairs at Central Connecticut State University in New Britain and another five years as associate vice president for academic affairs at the State University of New York at Binghamton. Before moving to New York, President Pattenaude was a member of the political science faculty and an associate dean for six years at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa.

A native of Seattle, Wash., he earned his bachelor's degree with honors in economics at California's San Jose State University and his Ph.D. in political science at the University of Colorado. His areas of expertise and publishing include American government, university leadership, public administration, and organizational theory.

Chancellor Pattenaude and his wife, Michele, have four adult children and have homes in Biddeford and Bangor.

#### LAST WEEK: TIM HUSSEY FROM HUSSEY SEATING

Last Friday, at the Holiday Inn by the Bay, we met Tim Hussey, the CEO of Hussey Seating, one of the oldest family-run businesses in Maine. This Maine company has been around a long time -Last year it celebrated its 175th anniversary, and Tim is part of the sixth generation of his family to run it.

Hussey started as a plow company in 1835, then morphed into a fabricator of steel products such as ski jumps and stepladders before settling into the bleacher and grandstand business. Now, it makes 800 to 900 seating systems per year, for venues ranging from the New England Patriots' Gillette Stadium to school gymnasiums around the country
