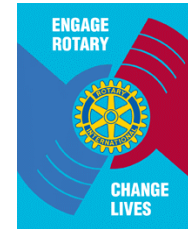

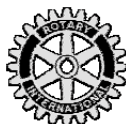

Announcing This Year’s United Miles Winners

Through the generous support of United Airlines and the votes of people around the world, Rotary once again received over 2.5 million miles through United’s 10 Million Charity Miles Giveaway. As a result, four students will receive free round-trip airfare for their 2013-14 exchanges: Valentine from the United States, Kim from France, Arturo from Peru, and Colton from Canada. We will share updates from these students throughout the year as they explore new cultures.

Tai, one of last year’s United miles winners, sent a final report from Japan in which he describes the pride of preparing tea for his friends during a traditional Japanese ceremony, the adjustments involved in transitioning to a new host family, and his commitment “to make this world a better place through peace and understanding.”

Your Rotary Foundation Account

Please check your Rotary Foundation account to make certain donations and transfer of points are showing properly. Many of you made donations to the Rotary Foundation this past year and many in the last quarter of the Rotary year when the Club was point matching your donations. Additionally, most of you made par on the Fruit Sale this past year and also the previous year. Please check your account to make certain that you received:

- 100 points for the 2011 Fruit Sale (if Par)
- \$100 for the 2012 Fruit Sale (if Par).
- matching points for donations made during April, May and June this year.

If there are any discrepancies, please let me know ASAP. I will need a copy of the printout from your account also.

To check your account click on “Member Access” at www.rotary.org and enter your email and password. On the Member Access page, click on “View Your Contribution History” near the bottom of the page. On the page that opens, under Individual Reports, click on “DonorHistoryReport.” After the query runs a document will open. On this document, click on the “Printer” icon at the top of the document which will open a new window with your history details formatted into a PDF document. (If you are using Windows 7 or 8, a popup at the bottom of the page will ask you if you want to open or save the document – open it for now.) Once open, you will notice that it is two or more pages long. The first page is your account summary and the pages that follow are the details. At this point you can print the document, save it or both.

Save it to your desktop and then can email it to me along with questions or discrepancies described which I can answer or look into. Please don’t send questions or problems without the document attached or I won’t be able to help. Please take care of this now since I will not be able to make any corrections after August. Thank you for all you do for Northwest Austin Rotary and the Rotary Foundation.
