Loudoun Community Health Center CEO Debra Dever has over 30 years of experience in health care with 12 years in executive positions in a variety of settings, including acute care, home health care, rehabilitation and primary care. She has a Master's degree in Nursing Service Administration, and Bachelor's degrees in Pre-Med and Nursing. She has a multi-cultural background including having lived in 4 foreign countries including 6 years in Mexico. Most recently, prior to coming to Loudoun Community Health Center, (LCHC) Debra was the Executive Director of Benewah Medical & Wellness Center, an award winning Tribally owned Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in Northern Idaho for 7 ½ years. Debra is responsible for putting together LCHC from scratch. Since seeing its first patients in May of 2007, LCHC has cared for 7,000 patients and grown from a staff of 5 to 27.

The Loudoun Community Health Center (LCHC) is a nonprofit, Federally Qualified Health Center created to provide health care in a medical home setting to those who have limited or no health insurance. LCHC's dedicated team of highly-trained doctors and nurses offer a wide range of services, including pediatrics, adult medicine, ob/gyn, mental health services, and lab work.

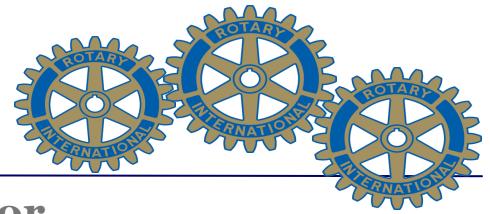
"Of the things we think say or do:
