Ashburn Welcomes Northern Virginia Family Services

Northern Virginia Family Service (NVFS) is a private, nonprofit community service organization dedicated to helping individuals and families find new paths to self-reliance and brighter futures. Originally established in 1924 by volunteers in Alexandria, NVFS help people in need throughout Northern Virginia communities. Those first volunteers in Alexandria noticed that poor children in their community had no coats and their families had no coal to heat their homes. NVFS provided assistance to address those basic, but critically important, needs.

Eighty-five years later, NVFS continues to address the needs of many communities in the region - over 20,000 individuals and families each year - with a wide range of programs designed to deal with the current problems of today.

Jennifer B. Rose, MPA came to Northern Virginia Family Service (NVFS) in the summer of 2008. As Community Giving Specialist, Jennifer works in the community to engage support for NVFS and its mission. She interacts regularly with the business community, service organizations, chambers of commerce, and other community groups.
