The District Simplified Grant program is recommending to support of the Rotary Club of Ashburn's project titled "Steuart W. Weller Elementary School Literacy Program." The District is forwarding their recommendation for an award of \$1,100 to the Rotary Foundation for approval and release of funds to the Club.

This year the DSG program received a large number of very strong competitive proposals with compelling humanitarian needs. With available funds, the program attempted to recommend as many worthy projects as possible at a reduced level. The level of funding recommendation was based on the viability of the project with the reduced funds, humanitarian needs, and overall rating of the project. The DSG program sincerely hopes that these projects could achieve overall stated goals and core humanitarian needs with the reduced funding from the DSG program.

Funds from the DSG, which requires a 10% match from the Club, will be used to purchase books through the "Keep Books" program for the students at Weller Elementary School in Ashburn.
