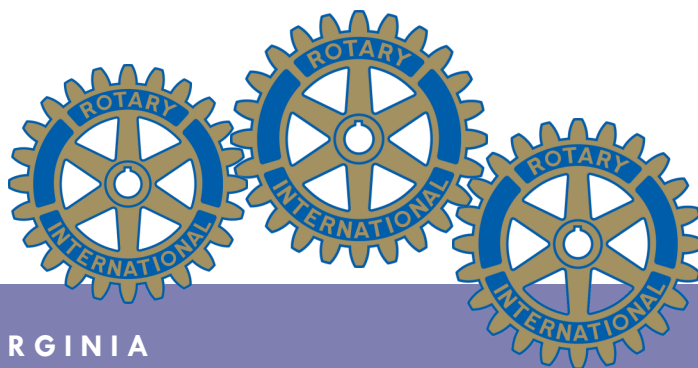

The Clock is Ticking... District 7610 Extends its Matching Points Deadline

The District's match program that began March 1 has been extended through April 30. With more than 12,000 points remaining at the district level to match gifts of \$500 or more to the Annual Fund (SHARE), the District 7610 matching program is the equivalent of two-for-one recognition for outright gifts of \$500 or more and for new Paul Harris Society members who join during the matching program period. Rotarians who make their gifts recurring gifts can realize a three-to-one benefit for a portion of their contribution made between April 1 and April 30, thanks to the TRF match.
