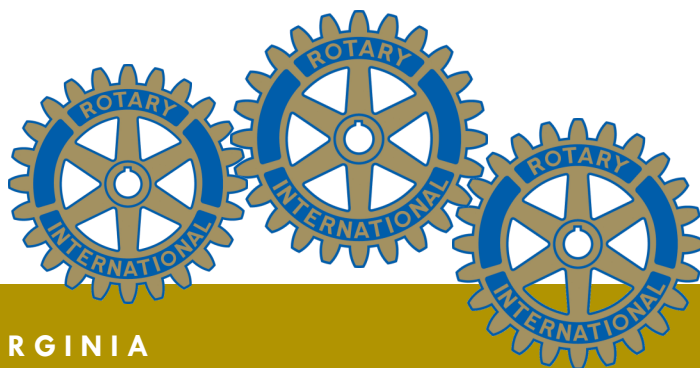

Diana Veseth-Nelson from the Loudoun Free Clinic will speak on Thursday, August 22.

Diana Veseth-Nelson, a is a non-profit professional with experience in executive management, program development and a seasoned speaker for non -profits. Currently, Diana is active as the Director of Volunteer Development and Public Relations at the Loudoun Free Clinic in Leesburg, VA. The Free Clinic, with over 200 medical providers, nurses and administrative professionals, serving over 1,300 patients, is the only free clinic in Loudoun County. In 2012, the Loudoun Free Clinic distributed 13,938 prescriptions valued at almost \$1.8 million to our patients. The clinic volunteers set a 10-year record with over 6,463 hours of service that valued at more than \$197,550 and delivered \$6 in medical care for every \$1 spent.

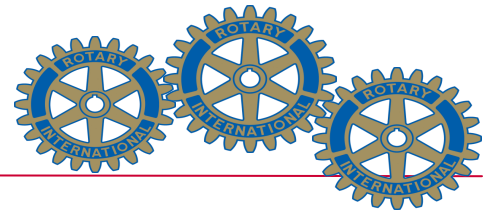
