- 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?"

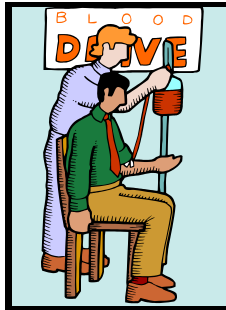


Reminders:
