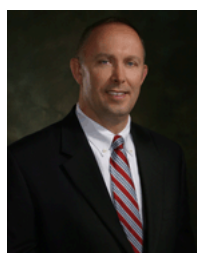

The Honorable Gary M. Clemens has served as clerk of the circuit court since January 2000. The clerk of the circuit court is responsible for the administration and executive management of a constitutional office and local courts agency. Mr. Clemens served as the president for the Virginia Association of Constitutional Officers in 2010. He served as president of the Virginia Court Clerks' Association in 2008. In 2005, he was awarded the Government Best Practices recognition from the International City/County Managers Association for his digital land records systems. In 2010, his office was honored with a Customer Service Award by the National Association of Counties for his Online Marriage License Application System.

Mr. Clemens has a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from James Madison University and a Masters Degree in Public Administration from George Mason University. He frequently makes presentations or gives lectures at professional association conferences, high school students and community service groups. Mr. Clemens is active in several community service organizations as he serves on the Board of Directors for the Loudoun County United Way, as Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Visit Loudoun Destination Foundation and the advisory board for the Patriot Project. He has coached or officiated youth sports in Loudoun County since 1988 including the Dulles Little League, Farmwell Station Basketball League, and Loudoun Youth Soccer. Mr. Clemens is a 47-year resident of Loudoun County, Virginia. He is an active member of St. Theresa's Catholic Church. He resides in Ashburn with his wife Maria, their three sons and one dog.

concerned?"

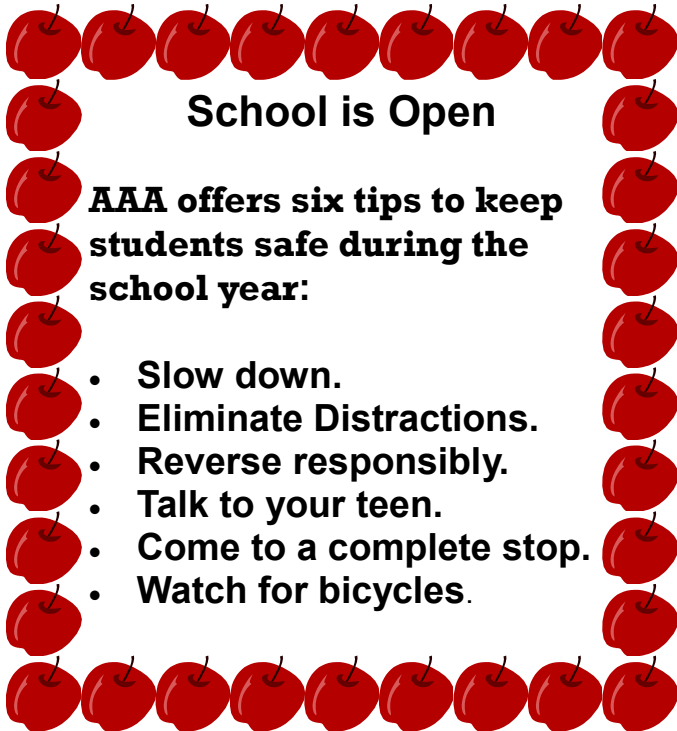


Wine Tour Scheduled:
